GUIDE Annual Aquaculture Statistical Report Shellfish Sector

Canada

Federal aquaculture licence holders are required to complete and submit the Annual Aquaculture Statistical Report (AASR) to DFO. This guide is intended for information purposes only for the shellfish sector.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- The AASR is a custom generated electronic PDF document, with a special form sent to each aquaculture licence holder each year. Use only the current AASR, and it must be completed and saved using Adobe Acrobat Reader https://get.adobe.com/reader/. Handwritten AASRs are not longer accepted. You may have to enable Java script to complete the form electronically.
- Some AASR sections require use of drop down arrows and selection of pre-listed options. To activate the drop down menu in each section, select *yes* to that question.
- Weights and measures must be provided in the measurement units on the AASR.
- Submit completed AASR by email to <u>DFO.PACAASR-RSAAPAC.MPO@dfo-mpo.gc.ca</u> by January 25 each year.
- Late submissions may be considered as non-compliance with the federal aquaculture licence.
 DFO Conservation and Protection may follow up and non-compliance may be publicly reported on the DFO website and elsewhere.

AASR SECTION 1 - HARVEST FOR FOOD MARKET SALES

Licence holders report the aquaculture product sold to the food market through processors or direct to customers (where processing permits are in place).

 - Acceptable Units of Measure:
 - Kilograms (kg) or pounds (Lbs) for all species
 - Dozen or gallows for oysters only
- Reportable units are consistent with Statistics Canada requirements. If licence holder operates in other units, it must be converted to a reportable unit of measure.

Licence holders must report their buyers and processing plants.


