Round 2 of the Innovative Shellfish Handling Program (ISH) will be open from 4-Jan-2022 till 14-February-2022.

The ISH covers up to 50% of the costs for innovative projects aimed at increasing the profitability, productivity, operational efficiency, and the growth of the industry. For the complete description see the ISH Guidelines.

How to write a good ISH application:

To write a successful ISH application members should consider how their project ideas fit the goals of the ISH and the ISH Adjudicating Criteria.

The objective of the ISH is to increase competitiveness by:

- facilitating growth
- increasing profitability
- increasing productivity
- increasing operational efficiency

No matter how big, small, or new your business is - members are eligible to apply for ISH and all applications will be evaluated in the context of the applicant's operation and the project cost.

What made for stronger applications in Round 1:

- The applicants started early and submitted applications before the deadline for feedback from the BCSGA project managers.
- The applications had authorization for introducing the project or infrastructure on their farm when required.
- They provided the Adjudicating Committee confidence that they have been transparent and diligent in development of their project.
- They included multiple quotes and diagrams of the proposed project and technology.
- They included realistic and trackable quantitative estimates of the effect of the project on their productivity and/or labor savings.
- They included letters of support from proponents, collaborators, and product distributors.
