from farms. Debris is an issue that has plagued our industry and created a huge administrative burden for the BCSGA and regulators. In September 2023, all members must be in compliance with the three pillars of SHEP described below. Debris: To be compliant members must not store aquaculture gear or equipment at the farm site unless it will be used in the current crop production cycle. Floatation: To be compliant members must ensure all foam floatation is encased in a rigid, durable and non-toxic shell. Predator Protection: To be compliant members must ensure that predator exclusion devices are constructed and maintained to prevent the entrapment and potential injury to wildlife. SHEP is a BCSGA program that does not absolve license holders to comply with regulations and requirements set by the authorizing bodies for shellfish aquaculture facilities.
